Presenter Audio/Video Best Practice

Presenter Audio/Video Best Practice	
1. Position Yourself in a Place with Consistent, High Speed Internet	
 Plug into Ethernet if possible (to be consistent) Move close to your Wi-fi Router (to minimise sources of Interference between Router and Device) 	(((WiFi)))
2. If possible, turn Off VPNs and Strict Corporate Firewalls	
 VPNs throttle upload speed, causing major lag VPNs/firewalls can block audio/video streams 	VPN
3. Use a Desktop/Laptop Computer	
 Restart your computer ahead of time Close Teams, Skype etc. so they don't interfere with your webcam Close excess programs + tabs to avoid using excess memory 	
 4. Camera angle/background Please ensure that you are facing the camera front on We would just advise that you do not have a light/window behind you, a ceiling fan on, or TV on. A quiet space with either a blank wall or office setting is the usual go-to. With regards to clothing: again, this is your own choice but we would recommend business casual. 	88

6. Screen share (if relevant)	
 Before you connect to the Zoom webinar, have your PowerPoint presentation open on your desktop, NOT in presenter mode. Click on the Share icon, either in the main window or in the control panel. Then click back into your PowerPoint presentation and click 'Slideshow' on the toolbar and 'Play from Start' (Make sure you keep the Zoom screen share box open throughout). Select the PowerPoint presentation you wish to display in the Zoom screen share box. Your slide deck will then come up as your main screen. If you are playing in audio, please ensure you tick 'share computer sound'.
